- 1. Waiver forms must be signed by parent/legal guardian (if under age 18) and turned in at registration.
- 2. There will be 4 players per team.
- 3. Entry fee will be \$25 per team.
- 4. There will be 2 divisions consisting of 15 years old and younger, and 16 years old and above. If two members of a team are 16 or older then the team must participate in the older division.
- 5. Tournament format: A single elimination tournament
- 6. Shoes are to be worn by all participants. No cleats allowed.
- 7. Shirts and shorts must be worn by all participants.
- 8. Trophies will be awarded to the winning teams.
- 9. <u>All the official's decisions are final. NO ARGUING!</u> Any harassment from a team or a participant toward the official may cause the elimination of that team or person from further participation.
- 10. Teams are to bring their own towels to clean off. Games will not be delayed to spray-off mud.
- 11. NO ONE ALLOWED IN OTHER AREAS OF THE FAIR WITH WET CLOTHES.
- 12. Outside Showers are available, bring change of clothes. NO ONE ALLOWED IN THE LAKE!
- 13. All players play at their own risk.

## **Dodgeball Rules**

The object of the game is to eliminate all opposing players by getting them "OUT". This may be done by:

- 1. Hitting an opposing player with a LIVE thrown ball below the shoulders.
- 2. Catching a LIVE ball thrown by your opponent before it touches the ground.

Definition: LIVE: A ball that has been thrown and has not touched anything, including the floor/ground, another ball, another player, official or other item outside of the playing field (wall, fence, etc.)

## **BOUNDARIES**

During play, all players must remain within the boundary lines. <u>Players may leave the boundaries through their end-line</u> <u>only to retrieve stray balls. They must also return through their end-line.</u>

## THE OPENING RUSH

Game begins by placing the 4 dodgeballs along the center line. Players then take a position behind their end line. Following a signal by the official, teams may approach the centerline to retrieve the balls. This signal officially starts the contest.

Court: 30' x 60'
